4: What needs were addressed?

About one-fifth of San Antonio's young children live in poverty. Providing basic necessities such as clothing can be a hardship for their families. Togs For Tots works to lessen this burden by providing low-income families with clothing and supplies for their children.

Low-income parents often lack the family support and child-rearing knowledge to adequately care for their growing children. Togs For Tots provides them with "Watch Me Grow from Head to Toe," a bilingual booklet designed to educate them about a baby's expected growth and development.

5: What method of evaluation did you use to monitor and measure the project's outcome and what are the result?

The success of Togs For Tots is measured primarily by a simple count of the number of children served. We also solicit input from participating agencies about the value of the program to their clients, the efficiency with which the program's service is delivered, and interest in future participation. We are also collecting client zip codes to help us determine where our services are needed most.

6: Do you plan to continue this project, and if so, how do you plan to sustain it?

Togs For Tots has operated since 1988 and will continue because of pressing economic need in our community. The 2020-2021 program is underway, having made minor logistical changes because of Covid-19. As usual, we will solicit grants from various philanthropic organizations, and we will conduct one major and several minor fundraising events to meet our programs' budgets.

The \$65,000 award from the Najim Foundation was used to purchase clothing for 2,120 children served by Togs For Tots. Thank you for this very generous support.
