o More than 50% of renter households pay 30% or more of their income on rent.

o There has been a 4.7% decline in the homeownership rate in San Antonio over the past decade.

o The average median sales price of a home in San Antonio was \$250,100 in 2020. The average 3 bedroom apartment rents for \$1,446/month.

Success meant building 51 homes in 2020 in partnership with families in need. The criteria and outcomes of this project were extremely measurable. We evaluated the success of this project by the successful transfer of title to our first-time homebuyers. We transferred title to all 51 families in 2020. Additionally, we measure the outcomes of our program by our low foreclosure rate.

6: Do you plan to continue this project, and if so, how do you plan to sustain it?

Habitat for Humanity of San Antonio will continue to build houses as we have the necessary funding.

Our Habitat family has successfully integrated into their new community. We are so excited about this newest Habitat community - it has great access to schools, employment and local parks all within a short drive.
