San Antonio Threads asked for assistance serving 1,500 youth funded by the Najim Family Foundation. We are excited to say we have served 1,679 youth in 2018.

San Antonio Threads projected to serve 1,500 youth, and exceeded that number serving 1,679 youth. The \$200 allocated for rolling racks was put towards the additional 179 youth.

4: What needs were addressed?

San Antonio Threads is focused on improving the future of San Antonio through our teens, working towards normalcy and foster reform. San Antonio Threads provides a safe and nurturing shopping environment through building a wardrobe and self care.

Youth are asked to leave a note at the completion of their shop letting us know how they feel, what they would change, and where their new clothes will take them. San Antonio Threads also tracks the youth and the entities who refer them.

San Antonio Threads will continue to serve youth, and is projected to serve over 3,000 teens in 2019. This is sustained by community clothing and toiletry drives, community donations, grant funding, and the philanthropists.
