Speaking with local placements or residences, caseworkers, and foster parents, we could easily equip interested youth with cell phone service. We were also able to complete the build-out of our new office space because we were unfortunately unable to obtain new computers for our lab; we are utilizing older laptops computers for our lab and are hoping to upgrade the office equipment soon.

The primary need addressed was ensuring that foster youth had the tools they needed to participate in education, workforce and maintain connections with caseworkers, friends, and family.
