Program / Project Description:

We have been providing toys to disadvantaged kids (Delivered by Santa & his elves) for 50+ years. What sets us apart is that we are STILL 100% volunteer, and approx. 98 cents of every dollar we raise goes towards this cause. It all started with one letter to Santa in 1969 from a girl named Anna, who wanted a tree, doll, and a bible for her mommy. Santa had never visited her house, but she still believed. All these years later we are now delivering to approx. 20,000 kids each year who would not otherwise experience the joy of Christmas. Santa and his elves spend quality time with each child. This sets us apart. So many of the families we serve end up volunteering themselves. We made such a positive impact on their life, and they wanted to give back. It comes full circle. With COVID19 this year, we know our donations will be down, and the need will be greater. We do not want to have to reduce the number of families we serve. It truly is a community wide effort. From the core volunteers who work year round and most have been with us over 30 years, to the thousands in the community who come out to volunteer to wrap or deliver, (even the Spurs provide two players to be Santa and deliver). Port SA generously donates a huge warehouse for our holiday operations. O'Haver Plumbing donates our year round office building. HEB allows us to use their buying power for the toys. WOAI partners with us for our main fundraiser, a Radiothon/Silent Auction at North Star Mall each year. We are a San Antonio institution, and the joy we bring has a positive impact on so many in a multitude of ways. It's even evident when Santa drives up with his elves to deliver to a family in crisis. Neighbors, various people outside, construction workers, etc. literally stop what they are doing and smile. For that moment, they forget their worries or hardships. They are brought back to a place in their childhood that gives them warm and happy memories. We all need that little reminder now and then, when this world can be so hard at times. Especially this year. With COVID19, the children simply don't have the capacity to fully understand all that has happend, and why their world has been turned upside down. It's so important to us for them to have something to look forward to, and to bring a sense of "normalcy" back to them. We want to assure them that "Christmas isn't cancelled".

Evaluation Plan:

We have not met our goal for fundraising the last two years. We are certainly concerned that with COVID19 we will receive even less in donor funds this year. We are reaching out to more Foundations and Companies for help. We plan to implement a newsletter, to go along with our social media to keep people engaged. All donor grants we receive are for operating expenses, as we have no paid staff and very minimal expenses. At the very least, our plan is to continue to serve 20,000 children this year.

Plans to sustain project beyond the term of this request:

Discussions are in progress to implement a legacy/endowment program, with help from Trinity University (our founder Louise Locker's alma mater). They have offered their expertise and we were planning a workshop right before COVID19 quarantine, so it has been put on hold for now. This will help sustain us for future years, and we are very excited about getting this off the ground. In the meantime, we will continue with our donor requests, annual fundraiser, and other creative fundraising ideas throughout the year.
