### Program / Project Description:

Lifeâ€™s Little Miracles, Corp. provides goods and services to Neonatal Intensive Care Units, children's shelters, independent school districts, and other organizations that assist infants and new mothers. The provisions, valued at approximately \$50 each, include donated items and information that supports the infants and their families during their stay in the hospital and beyond. If quantity allows, the goal is to distribute at least 200 care packages at the end of each quarter. 100% of all proceeds are allocated to purchasing baby hats, shirts or onesies (in preemie and newborn size), diapers, nursing supplies, and other baby care items, to printing literature in the form of pamphlets and brochures for parents of preemies to reference as they are on their preemie journey, and to cover operational costs. We also include coupons (and samples) from our sponsors that the parents and guardians of the infants can use in retail stores. This will lighten the load for the parents and even allow the parents of preemies to take photos of their babies in clothing rather than practically naked with several tubes attached to the hands, feet, bellies, noses, and mouths. Photos in the clothing will help to camouflage the painful or uncomfortable state the infants are in, which also helps the parents feel a sense of relief and progress in the unfortunate situation. These products are distributed in the San Antonio, TX area, but if there is a surplus we definitely expand our donations outside of this locale.

### Evaluation Plan:

We do encourage the recipients, both medical personnel and parents of the preemies alike, to contact us with feedback regarding the care packages. We want to know if there are any improvements to be made or if additional items are needed that have yet to be included in the boxes. We also wish to know if our program is beneficial so we plan to include short surveys on our website and in the care packages to come. We know that our program is successful as we receive more referrals to expand our services within the community.

### Plans to sustain project beyond the term of this request:

We conduct community outreach and request grants and donations from corporations and individuals alike. We also plan to closely monitor our expenses versus revenue to make sure that we are meeting goals and not overspending so that the program may continue to impact the community for many years to come.
