On September 11, 2021 we will be providing school shoes for low-income school children in the San Antonio community. Every year we give shoes to 2,000-2,500 children in need. The children are pre-registered by referrals from their schools. They come to The Salvation Army Mission Corps at 3802 SW Military Drive, San Antonio, TX 78211. In the past we have covered the cost of the shoes out of existing program funds, and have bought the cheapest shoes we could find. Our desire is to give a better quality of shoes to the children and in order to do so, we are seeking funding for this project. At \$10 per pair of shoes, it will cost \$20,000-\$25,000.

We want the neediest children in our community to be able to start the school year with good shoes.

Evaluation Plan:

When the families come to pick out their shoes, we track the number of families, the ages of the children, the zip codes of residence, and the number of pairs of shoes given out. Our goal is 2,500 children helped.

Plans to sustain project beyond the term of this request:

We will need to find funding for this project every year. It will still go on, but the money will come out of other programs without outside funding. We need a permanent sponsor to make this program sustainable for the future.
